




Community for Change

Some lessons learned

COMMUNITY BUILDING

- Set a narrative
- Participants with interests aligned with the project, with their skills and time availability.
- Start with small and manageable tasks
- Stay connected with other participants and the project team
- Offer support and training

ENGAGEMENT & MOTIVATION

- The tasks to be carried out make sense and are meaningful
- Give value to the knowledge and skills of the participants
- Provide continuous feedback to the community, and updated information
- Always offer transparency
